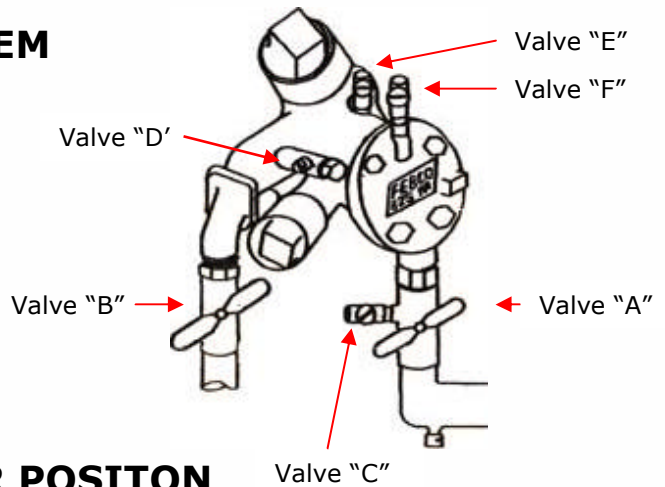


COMERCIAL (825) TURNING YOUR SPRINKLER SYSTEM BACK ON IN THE SPRING

We suggest that you save this sheet by your timer or by your sprinkler shut-off valve downstairs and that you wait until at least **MID APRIL** to turn your system back on.

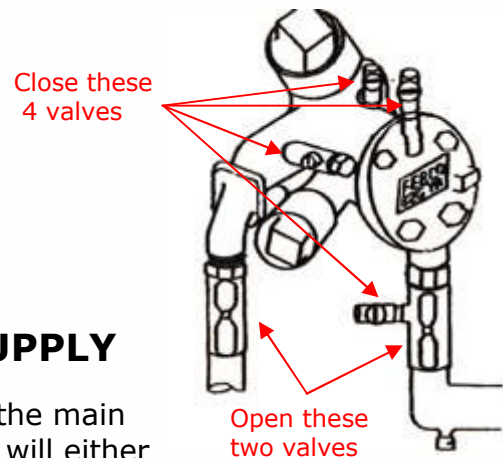
THIS IS HOW WE LEFT YOUR SYSTEM

We leave all manifold drains outside **CLOSED**. If you have caps for valves "E" and "F", then they were left at a 45 degree angle and will need to be closed (turned perpendicular) in step one.



STEP ONE: SET VALVES TO PROPER POSITION

OUTSIDE, Close valves "C" and "D"
 (Closed means perpendicular to the pipe)
THEN, Open valves "A" and "B"
 (Open means parallel with the pipe)
NOTE, Valves "E" and "F" should be closed now



STEP TWO: TURN ON THE WATER SUPPLY

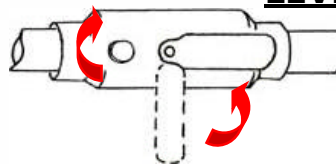
DOWNSTAIRS, Close the petcock first then open the main sprinkler valve. There are two types of valves. You will either have a Turn Type (below left) or a Lever Type (below right)

TURN TYPE



Turn petcock clockwise then turn main valve counter-clockwise

LEVER TYPE



Turn petcock clockwise then turn lever parallel with pipe

These three steps take less than 5 minutes and will save you the \$40 or more turn-on fee. Don't forget about spring aeration, fertilizing, and power raking!
