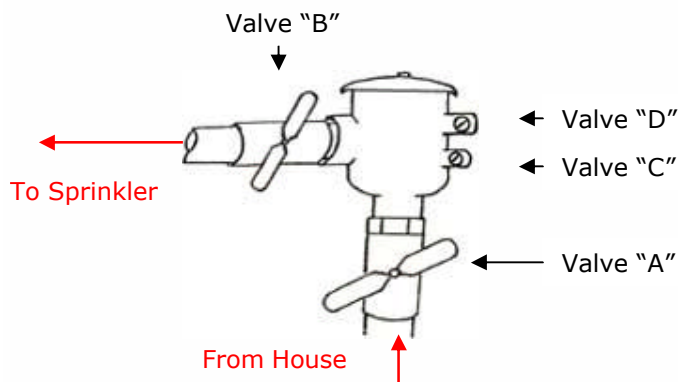


RESIDENTIAL TURNING YOUR SPRINKLER SYSTEM BACK ON IN THE SPRING

We suggest that you save this sheet by your timer or by your sprinkler shut-off valve downstairs and that you wait until at least **MID APRIL** to turn your system back on.

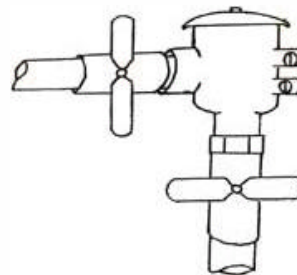
THIS IS HOW WE LEFT YOUR SYSTEM

We leave all manifold drains outside closed



STEP ONE: CLOSE ALL VALVES OUTSIDE

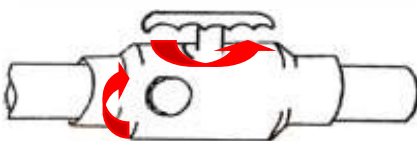
Outside, close all valves (A, B, C, and D)
 Closed means the handle should be perpendicular to the pipe



STEP TWO: TURN ON WATER INSIDE HOUSE

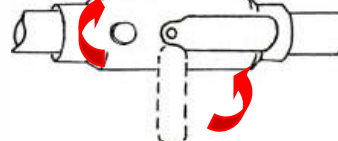
In your house, close the petcock and then open the main sprinkler valve.
 See the below diagram of the two types of valves: Turn-type, or Lever-type

TURN TYPE



Turn petcock clockwise then turn main valve counter-clockwise

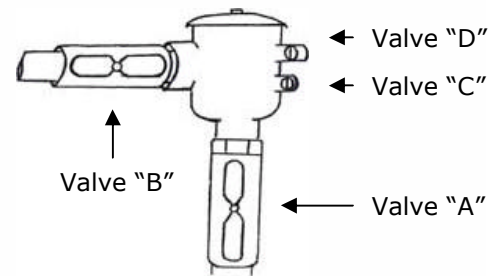
LEVER TYPE



Turn petcock clockwise then turn lever parallel with pipe

STEP THREE: TURN ON VALVES OUTSIDE

Outside, open valve A first, then valve B
 Leave C and D closed



These three steps take less than 5 minutes and will save you the \$40 or more turn-on fee.
 Don't forget about spring aeration and fertilizing!
